

## **Annual Mocanaqua Loop Trail Hike**

The event will introduce hikers to the Mocanaqua Loop Trail System, with incredible views of the Susquehanna River and remnants of historic mining activity. Multiple trails will be open for the event. Please wear appropriate hiking shoes/boots and clothes for easy to moderate terrain. Bring rain gear in inclement weather. Water will be provided, but we suggest bringing your own non-disposable bottle to reduce waste. Trail bars will also be provided to hikers. The hike will begin promptly at 10 a.m.

To get to the Mocanaqua Loop trails, take PA Rt. 11 South through Shickshinny. Turn left onto Rt. 239, crossing bridge to Mocanaqua. Immediately after bridge, turn left onto Main Street. Trail parking area is 340 feet. From the South: Take PA Rt. 11 North to Shickshinny. Turn right onto Main Street Bridge, crossing to Mocanaqua. Immediately after bridge, turn left onto Main Street. Trail parking area is 340 feet.
